The 2003 **VICTORY POINT** Cabernet Sauvignon has red and dark berries; red currant, black currant and mulberry. These combine with leather and earthy complexity, soft smoky oak and a background of violets and cedar. This concentration and structure reflect the small crops of the 2003 season and they give the wine power and complexity for aging.
